6.- CATEGORIES AND CLASSES

Motorcycles of the following classes are eligible:

See Technical Specifications art. 2.6 and 2.7 of the Endurance World Championship Road Racing Regulations

FORMULA EWC: 4 cylinders over 600 cc up to 1000 cc 4 stroke
3 cylinders over 750 cc up to 1000 cc 4 stroke
2 cylinders over 850 cc up to 1200 cc 4 stroke

SUPERSTOCK: 4 cylinders over 600 cc up to 1000 cc 4 stroke
3 cylinders over 750 cc up to 1000 cc 4 stroke
2 cylinders over 850 cc up to 1200 cc 4 stroke

Another class « Open » may be allowed to enter. Meanwhile the teams of this class will not be classified and will not receive the prizes and allocations.

7.- NUMBER OF TEAMS ALLOWED

The maximum number of riders allowed will be as follows:

8.- ENTRIES, ENTRY FEE

Applications for entry must be made on the official forms included with these regulations.

Applications must be approved by the rider's FMN and must reach the organisers not later than 10th April 2008 midnight.

The organiser will select the applications and advise riders within 72 hours after the closing date of entries whether their applications have been accepted or reject.

The entry fee for the Albacete Event will be 300 € (except for the contracted teams).

The maximum deposit amount for transponders is **300 €**



9.- TECHNICAL AND SPORTING INSPECTIONS AND BRIEFINGS

No rider or machine is permitted onto the track unless he/it has passed the technical inspections which will be held according to the following schedule.

A photocopy of the license of each rider and team attending the briefing will be made.

A compulsory briefing for all riders participating in the Championship or Cup will take place on Thursday at 18'00 h. in the briefing room.

A compulsory briefing for all team managers participating in the Championship or Cup will take place on Thursday at 19'00 h. in the briefing room.

10.- PRACTICES

It is strictly forbidden to ride racing motorcycles on the course outside the official practice periods.

11.- RACES: SCHEDULES AND DISTANCES

Date of the start: 10th May 2.008

Time: 18'00 hrs.

Distance: 06 Hours

Minimum to be classified: Completed 75% of the number of laps carried out by the winner and having crossed the finish line on the race track within 5 minutes (see Art. 1.22.5).

According to Art. 1.16.15 of Road Racing World Championship Endurance Regulations, the the race start will be made with **the National Flag dropped.**



12.- PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING

The prizes shall be paid according to the CCR Rules.

Payment of prizes will be done **by Bank Transfer next 12th May Monday after the end of the race.**

IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO OBTAIN THE BANK DETAILS OF EVERY TEAM (ACCOUNT NUMBER, SWIFT CODE AND BIC NUMBER).

13.- PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of **800 USD (or counter-value in Euros).**

14.- FUEL

If fuel is supplied by the organizers at the fuel-station, it will be in conformity with Article 2.10 of the Road Racing Endurance Technical Regulations.

15.- INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider is insured in accordance with the FIM requirements.

In conformity with Article 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders covering accidents occurring during the meeting including practices will be the responsibility of the organiser.

This insurance includes a Third Party guarantee of a minimum of **€ 3.000.000.-**

The organiser disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

16.- RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the FIM Sporting Code, riders and teams by participating renounce all rights of appeal against the organiser, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIM Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organiser, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.
